

# 2006 NWT Broomball Championships

## CRITERIA AND GUIDELINES

1. There will be 4 divisions at this tournament. They are women's, men's, mixed competitive and mixed non-competitive.
2. Each community will be allowed multiple teams per division.
3. There will be a limit of 6 teams per division.
4. In the event 6 different teams cannot be represented in a division the hosting community will have first rights to enter an additional team.
5. In the event there is more than 1 vacancy in a division, additional vacancies will be decided by a draw of interested communities
6. The entry fee structure for the tournament is as follows:

<b>Women's</b>	\$650.00 per team
<b>Men's</b>	\$650 per team
<b>Mixed Competitive</b>	\$650 per team
<b>Mixed Non-competitive</b>	\$400 per team

7. **All players participating in the tournament are required to be registered with the NWT Broomball Association.** This is in addition to the entry fee. To complete each team must fill out the team registration form and submit annual dues of \$20 per player prior to commencing play in the tournament.
8. Attendance by all teams at the closing ceremonies is mandatory.
9. Banquet tickets are included with your entry fee. The tickets will be available to teams as part of your registration package prior to the start of the tournament. Extra tickets for guests are \$25 each.
10. The following is divisional criteria for the tournament:

### **Women's Division**

- As per CBF and NWT Broomball Association rules
- Minimum of 11 and maximum of 18 players per team
- Must have a non-playing coach
- Player must play in tournament to be eligible to go to Nationals Competition

**Men's Division**

- As per CBF and NWT Broomball Association rules
- Minimum of 11 and maximum of 18 players per team
- Must have a non-playing coach
- Player must play in tournament to be eligible to play on Raven's team

**Mixed Competitive Division**

- As per CBF and NWT Broomball Association rules
- Minimum of 11 and maximum of 18 players per team
- Must have a non-playing coach

**Mixed Non-competitive Division**

- As per modified Ironman rules
- Can have a playing coach
- Minimum of 7 and maximum of 11 players per team
- Minimum of 3 women on the ice at all times
- Maximum of 3 league players per team\*
  
- \*A league player is defined as a person who is a member of a men's, women's, mixed, and/or junior team that has competed in organized play or regularly scheduled games within the past year.

11. There are no restrictions for players willing to compete in one or more divisions with the exception of those imposed by the Non-competitive division.
